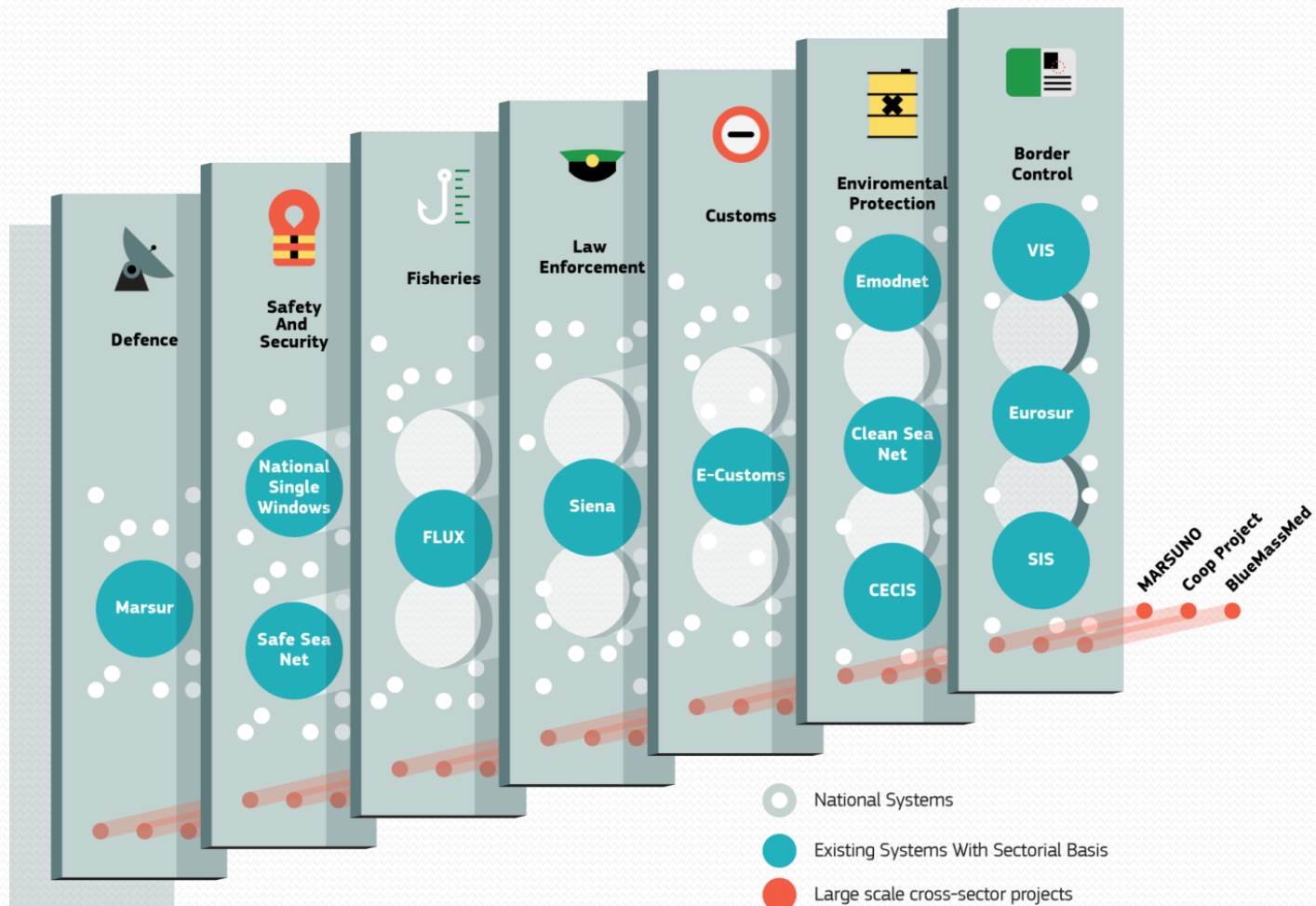

Building CISE : an ongoing process



EUCISE2020 has reached a critical state

- At this stage, major achievements can be considered as reached :
 - Operative infrastructure among 10 national nodes
 - Information exchange among more than 16 legacy systems of maritime administrations belonging to 10 European States
 - New version of the Common Data and Service models
 - Requirements and technical specifications for the common testbed
 - First software components (EUCISE2020 Node/Gateway)
- But the project will end in December 31 2018 without any uniform and stable political and financial frame

What is the added value of securing EUCISE 2020 infrastructure future ?

- The interoperability standards could:
 - Encourage authorities to invest more resources in the exchange of information across Europe
 - Benefit the European Industry, which will provide solutions adapted to the standard (stable, mature)
 - Promote Europe in its worldwide ambition
- Fostering new projects and new interactions between communities
- A support to improve the collection, fusion, analysis, optimisation and dissemination of information through new advanced services
- Give access to a large scope of data

Solutions for the transition period

- Transition project between 2018 and 2020 :
 - involving the MS already connected and other MS/authorities interested
 - Implemented through a Grant Agreement between DG Mare and a consortium
- Agreement between a legal entity and DGMare
 - A european consortium of MS with support from interested EU Agency(ies)
 - A european consortium of MS and EU Agency(ies);
 - EU Agency;

And next ?

- A governance on strategic and operational level must be thought on in order to :
 - Maintain, spread, connect, organize...
- Defined on a balanced and effective stakeholder representation
- Supported strongly by the Agency(ies)
