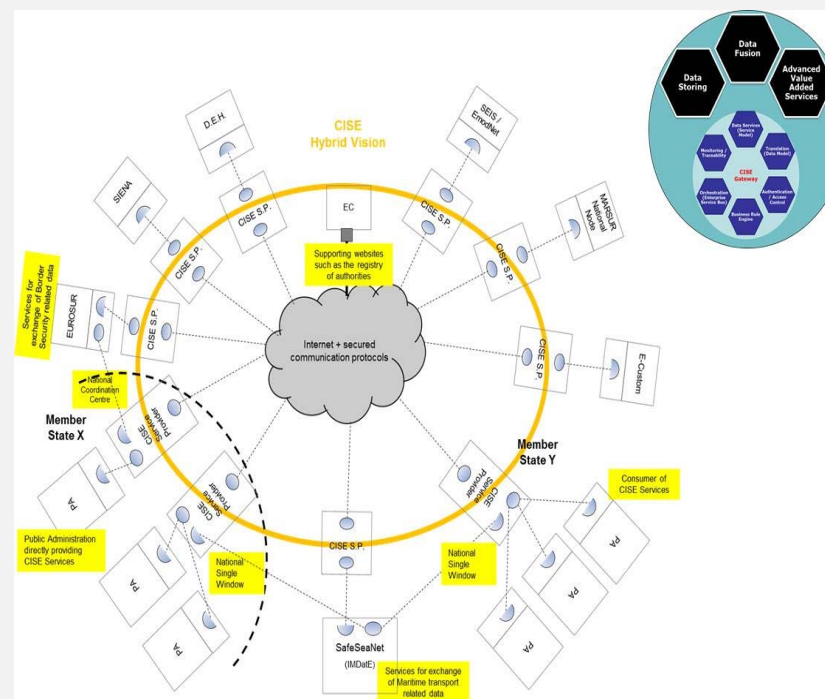

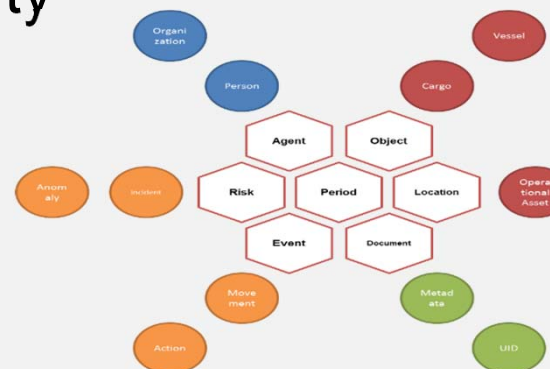

Technical Standardization

- European Telecommunication Standards Institute ETSI offers competent expert community
- Advantages:
 - Open to non- ETSI participant
 - Public – industrial cooperation
 - Flexible procedures in an ISG
 - Evolutionary approach ISG - TC
- Implementation process initiated, documentation finalized

Technical Standardization

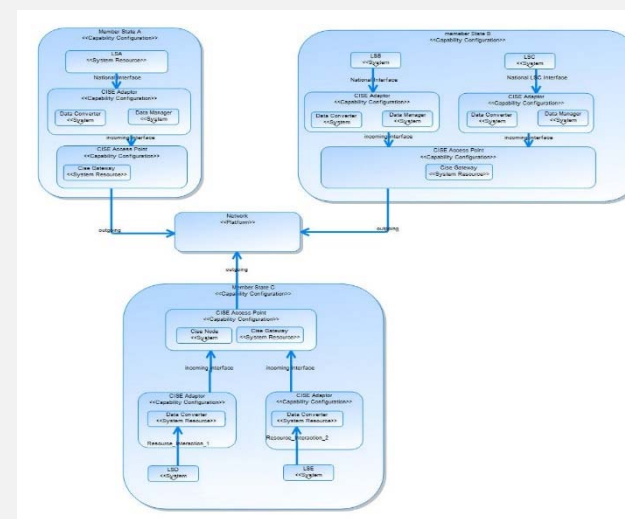
- ETSI Board approval expected by end March 2019
- ISG Kick- off meeting planned for mid April 2019

- Expected results:
 - European specifications for cross- sectoral network architecture
 - Can be blueprint for further cross- sectoral information exchange



Operational Standardization

- Network operation requires common operational procedures
- CISE Operational Guidelines as framework for system configuration and operation
- Will remain a «living document» to be modified and finalized during CISE Transition, and implemented for CISE Operational Phase

Responsibility to Share Policy (RTS)

- Cornerstone of CISE information exchange
- Essential for «voluntary» CISE operations
- Critical mindchange by users required (away from «need to know» principle)
- Challenging to implement
 - rules vs voluntariness
 - confidentiality vs sharing
 - well established «need to know» culture

Responsibility to Share Policy (RTS)

Proposals:

- Political commitment to RTS by joining CISE
- Technical monitoring to foster adherence to RTS (non-incriminating)
- «Audit Scheme» as incentive to RTS, and as support to analyze institutional obstacles
- Audit considered essential for RTS success, and should be further investigated during Transition

EUCISE2020 IPR Proposal

- EUCISE2020 IPR on core and common services rest with Consortium (Deliverable D 5.1)
- Similar IPR policy should be adopted for CISE Transition and Operation
- Transfer of EUCISE2020 IPR to CISE Transition and CISE Operation required
- Legal and procedural issues for IPR transfer raised

EUCISE2020 IPR Proposal

➤ Options:

- Convert IPR into open source as EUPL
- Transfer IPR to COM
- Transfer IPR to a MS entity signing Cooperation agreement
- Transfer IPR to the CISE Stakeholder Group set up as a Legal entity?

Problem: all options need IPR issues solved – timely solution before end of EUCISE2020 POV «ambitious»

In any case, a transfer agreement must be concluded

EUCISE2020 IPR Proposal

➤ **Alternative:**

- Extend EUCISE2020 Consortium Agreement according to art. 9.2 CA
- Solve IPR related issues of individual Consortium partners
- Decide on appropriate solution before end of Transition

Grant full license unlimited in purpose to EMSA for Transition Phase
